**TAX ASSESSMENT NO. 7 OF GEORGE W. VAUGHAN**

The collection consists of an assessment of the value of cattle, horses, and mules owned by George W. VAUGHAN of Prince Edward County, Virginia, in 1863.

**GEORGE W. VAUGHAN (ca.1815-aft.1870)**

George W. VAUGHAN was born ca. 1815 in Nottoway County, Virginia. He married 10 December 1834 Lucinda J. FARLEY, daughter of M. B. FARLEY, in Prince Edward County. He was appointed school commissioner for his district in Prince Edward County in 1854. According to the census of 1860, George W. VAUGHAN and his wife had one adopted daughter, Molly A. VAUGHAN. In 1860, he had real estate valued at \$5,000 and personal estate valued at \$26,000. George W. VAUGHAN died sometime after 1870.
