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Speaking with Charles Bryce, Historian, Petersburg National Battlefield Park on 6-24-2011 he advises me that most of the wounded who died at the General Hospital Petersburg were buried at the Blandford Church, Petersburg in mass unmarked graves. He looked up the name on the Blandford Church Records, but did not find his name, but said that was not unusual. He is 99% sure Thomas is buried at Blandford. He also advised me that most of the Confederate soldier who died on the battlefields in Petersburg were taken to Blandford Church.
