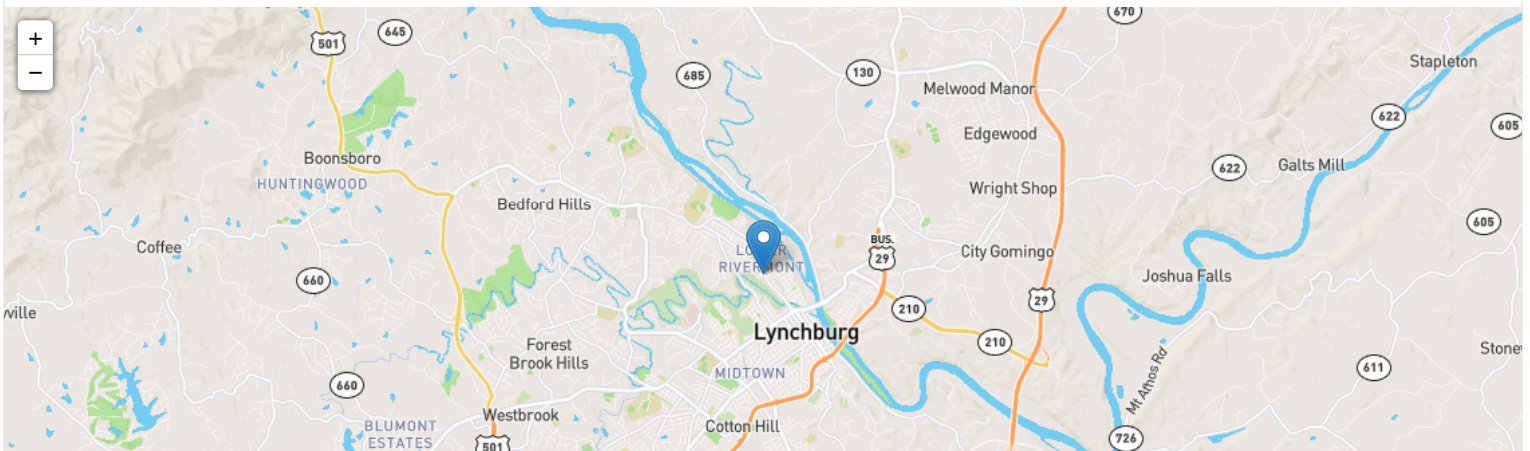
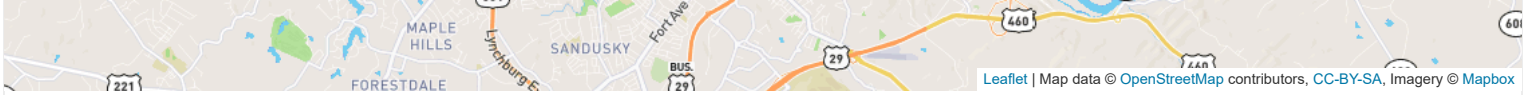

Most windows are 1/1 sash although some diamond-paned windows are in the dormer.
