ELIZABETH HARRIS McDANIEL (1921-1999)

Elizabeth Harris McDaniel, “Eliza”, was born 19 November 1921 in Lynchburg, Virginia, the daughter of Ellis Bibb McDaniel and Inez Roseman Clark. She was educated in Lynchburg, at Farmville State Teachers College (now Longwood College), and at Lynchburg College. She worked at Appalachian Power Company and Millners Department Store. She married Earl Randolph Blankenship.

Eliza McDaniel Blankenship died 19 April 1999 in Lynchburg and is buried in Spring Hill Cemetery.
