SECTION 1:

a. Those eligible for Active membership are women no less than sixteen years of age who are blood descendants, lineal, or collateral, of men and women who served honorably in the Army, Navy, or Civil Service of the Confederate States of America, or gave Material Aid to the Cause. Also eligible are those women who are lineal descendants of members or former members of UDC.
