Mary Lou Randle Roberts was born in Madison, WS, and lived in New Jersey and Virginia Beach, VA. A teacher by profession, she also did family research and became a recognized genealogist. She published Three hundred years of Bull-Randal-Randle history: England, Virginia, North Carolina & Georgia. She was a member of several hereditary societies including DAR, National Society of Colonial Dames XVII Century, Daughters of American Colonists and a member of the Jamestowne Society. She died 15 October 2013 in Lynchburg, VA, and was buried at Maplewood Cemetery in Gordonsville, VA.
