LN, November 15, 1933

William R. Barksdale, Jr., 59, died yesterday following a heart attack at his home, 800 Court Street, Lynchburg. He was a son of Judge William R. Barksdale and Hallie Craddock, and came to Lynchburg in 1893 to join the Craddock-Terry Shoe Company. He married in 1904 to Mary Morgan, who survives him. Other survivors: daughters Mrs. Holmes Alexander of New York City, and Hallie Craddock Barksdale of Lynchburg; sisters Mrs. E.B. Craddock of Cluster Springs, Mrs. T.C. Watkins of South Boston, Mrs. John Martin of Halifax, and Mary L. Barksdale of Halifax; brothers C.C. Barksdale of Richmond; Dr. Elisha Barksdale of Lynchburg; Major A.D. Barksdale of Lynchburg; and John C. Barksdale of Lynchburg.

LDA, March 16, 1945

William Morgan, formerly of Gladys, died March 15, 1945, in Harriman, Tennessee. Burial in Gladys on Sunday. Survivors: wife; sons Clifton & William (both in Army); daughter Mrs. W.D. Witt, Lynchburg; brothers Hugh & Clarke of Gladys; sister Emma Suddith of Gladys.

LN, July 21, 1950

Richard Clark Morgan, died July 20, 1950, at Virginia Baptist Hospital in Lynchburg, he had been a patient for about one month. Born November 5, 1881, in Gladys, Virginia. He served as postmaster there 1928-1950. Survivors: wife Josephine Wood Morgan of Gladys; sister Mrs. Elmore Suddith of Gladys.

LN, January 4, 1953

Mrs. Mary Morgan Barksdale, widow of William Randolph Barksdale, Jr., of 800 Court Street, Lynchburg, died in her sleep, January 3, 1953. She was born in Gladys, Virginia, daughter of R.W. & M.J. Morgan. Her sister, Georgia Morgan, died several months ago. She was married June 21, 1904, and was a member of Memorial Methodist Church, Women's Club of Lynchburg, Antiquarians, and the Lynchburg Garden Club. Survivors: daughters Mrs. Holmes Alexander of Baltimore and Hallie Craddock Barksdale of Lynchburg; brother Peyton Morgan of Lynchburg; 3 grandchildren.

LN, March 15, 1955
