IDA BOWMAN YOUNGER (1903-1993)

Ida Bowman YOUNGER, the daughter of Samuel Bransford YOUNGER and Ida Florence BOWMAN, was born 26 July 1903, in Lynchburg, Virginia. In 1922, Miss YOUNGER was a stenographer for the Piedmont Motor Car Company, and lived at *Rose Alba* in the Peakland section of Lynchburg. In 1923, she was a stenographer for KEMP, BARKSDALE, and ABBOT, a law firm. She continued as stenographer and secretary in the law firm, later BARKSDALE and ABBOT, and ABBOT, OULD and WARD, until 1939. In 1940, she became secretary to Judge Alfred D. BARKSDALE, judge of the District Court in Lynchburg. She remained in that position until her retirement in ca. 1972. A member of First Baptist Church, Miss YOUNGER died 20 April 1993 and was buried in the Presbyterian Cemetery in Lynchburg.
