FRIENDS OF RIVERMONT/FRIENDS OF RIVERMONT HISTORICAL SOCIETY

A group of Rivermont Avenue (Lynchburg, Virginia) residents began meeting in September 2000 to try to gain recognition as a historic district for the houses facing the avenue from the Rivermont Bridge to the Oakwood Country Club. Formal status as a non-profit organization occurred during the winter of 2001 and the name Friends of Rivermont (FOR) was chosen. In July 2001, the Lynchburg City Council turned down the proposal.

After much effort, the petition to create an historic district was again brought to City Council and approved on March 12, 2002. In 2007-08 the name of the original group was changed to Friends of Rivermont Historical Society (FORHS). The organization ceased operation in 2020.
