ARTICLE III

Eligibility

SECTION 1:

- a. Those eligible for Active membership are women no less than sixteen years of age who are blood descendants, lineal or collateral, of men and women who served honorably in the Army, Navy, or Civil Service of the Confederate States of America, or gave Material Aid to the Cause. Also eligible are those women who are lineal descendants of members or former members of JDC. Adopted children are not eligible for membership by virtue of the adoptive parents' blood-line, but solely by virtue of the natural or biological parents.
- b. No applicant whose ancestor took the Oath of Allegiance before April 9, 1865, shall be considered eligible. If further proof of service is available, therefore nullifying the Oath of Allegiance, the applicant shall be considered for membership.

- a. Applicants for Active membership shall fill out three original application forms or one original and two photocopies of same and shall be accepted as prescribed in General, Division and Chapter Bylaws.
