Poplar Forest Chapter, Daughters of the American Revolution, was organized 1 October 1913, with Ella Gordon CARRINGTON, formerly of Blue Ridge Chapter, DAR, as organizing regent. The Chapter was formed by daughters of the members of the Blue Ridge Chapter. The Chapter has made contributions to historic foundations, has assisted in the preservation of records, and has participated in beautification projects, such as Operation Plant-A-Tree. In 1929, the Chapter arranged to have a bronze tablet honoring Thomas JEFFERSON placed at Poplar Forest, his home in Bedford County, Virginia.
