Cabinet maker; member of International Order Odd Fellows; six feet tall; died at 10:00 a.m. at 1905 Grace St. of consumption (TB). He married (1) BETTIE VIRGINIA SHARP February 24, 1875 in Lynchburg, Va., daughter of JOSEPH SHARP. She was born 1858 in Smyth Co. Va., and died May 20, 1882 in Lynchburg, Va.. He married (2) MARTHA (MATTIE) T. PLEASANTS September 25, 1883 in Lynchburg, Va., daughter of SAMUEL PLEASANTS and ISABELLA. She was born September 25, 1866 in Lynchburg, VA; After Samuel died, a friend of Mattie Pleasants, Lillie Jennings, invited Mattie to go the train station to meet her male order husband, Mr. Flaherty. When Mr. Flaraghty met the ladies, he became interested in Mattie and married her., and died January 06, 1936 in Lynchburg, Va..

In 1875 he was cabinetmaker and lived on Campbell/Court House Rd.; In 1876/77 he was listed as a wheelwright and lived on Franklin St.; in 1883 he worked at 1901 Grace St. and owned property at 1903 and 1905 Grace St. He lived at 1740 Locust St. which runs perpendicular to Grace St. At this time he also worked for John P. Pettyjohn & Co.
