Will Book #4, 1927, Lynchburg Circuit Court

WILL OF: Mary Susan Plunkett Glass

Mary S. Glass, of the City of Lynchburg, in the State of Virginia, being of sound mind and disposing memory, do hereby make, publish and declare this to be my last will, hereby revoking all former wills by me at any time made:

First: I desire the payment of all just debts, which I shall owe at the time of my death, including an amount paid out by R. Jester, Jr. for Edmund S. glass in accordance with my request.

Second: I hereby give and bequeath all household and kitchen furniture and personal property that I own to Nannie G. Jester, Lillie G. Paris, H. W. Glass, and Edmund S. Glass to be divided between them, equally. All furniture and perswonal property in my residence that belongs to the said Lillie G. Paris and Edmund S. Glass shall be turned over to them after my death.

Third: I hereby give, devise and bequeath to the said Edmund S. Glass the following real estate in the city aforesaid to-wit: (1) a certain lot on Grace Street between Globe and Tyree St. commencing at the corner of the property of the said R. Jester, Jr., on Grace Street, and thence running along the line of Grace Street about 48 feet in the direction of Tyree Street and running back that uniform width between parallet lines in the direction of Lee Steet to the line of the property owned now by H. W. Glass and R. Jester, Sr., (2) a lot on Tyree St. between Grace and Lee St. beginning at the corner of property now owned by the said H. W. Glass and R. Jester, Sr. on Tyree St., and running along the line of Tyree St.,

30 feet in the direction of Grace Street and thence back between parallel lines in the direction of the Presbyterian Cemetery to the line of the said lot devised to the said Edmund S. Glass as described above.

Fourth: I hereby give and bequeath to my three children, the said Nannie G. Jester, Lillie G. Paris, and H. W. Glass, all of the remainder of my real estate to be divided between them equally. Should they desire to sell it, it is my request that R. Jester, Sr. shall be first given the privilege of buying it.

Fifth: I have three policies in the Life Insurance Co. of Va. I hereby direct that my executor hereinafter named, shall use the proceeds therefrom as follows, to-wit: (1) to the payment of my funeral and burial expenses; doctor's and drug accounts, if any are unpaid; (2) to erect a tombstone over my grave in the Presbyterian Cemetery which tombstone I desire to be similar to that over the grave of my deceased husband; (3) the sum of fifty dollars shall be turned over to the proper authorities of the aforesaid cemetery for the care of my lot therein. (4) The balance of such proceeds, if any, shall be applied to the payment of any debts I may owe.

Sixth: I hereby nominate and appoint the said R. Jester, Sr. as executor of this my last will and testament and having perfect confidence in him, it is my request that he shall be permitted to qualify as such without giving any surety on any bond that may be required of him.

In testimony whereof, I have hereunto set my hand and seal to this my last will and testament, this the 1st day of December, 1924.
