Article V - Section 6a**

Section 6a - Upon invitation a young woman member of the Children of the Confederacy 16 years or older may transfer to a Chapter of the United Daughters of the Confederacy. The Transfer applications shall be in quadruplicate, each originally signed, filled out by the Chapter from which the member is transferring, and shall be sent to the Business Office for official stamp. The Business Office shall send the applications to the Third Vice President General for signature. The Third Vice President General shall return one copy to the Children of the Confederacy Chapter from which the member is transferring. The Third Vice President General shall send the original and two copies to the UDC Chapter to which the applicant is transferring.

A young man may transfer to the Sons of Confederate Veterans subject to the By-Laws of the Sons of Confederate Veterans.
