Son Taylor Morgan  
215 acres of land, bounded as follows. From Kedron Church, 100 yards south along Pannill's Road to a line across the long field; thence to William C. Perrow's line; thence to the lines of Gilbert Hayth and James Connelly; thence back to Kedron Church.

Son R.W. Morgan  
Property on Pannill's Road, bounded as follows. From C.W. Flynn's Corner, 60 feet west; thence 30 feet south; thence 60 feet east to Pannill's Road; thence north to starting point. For the purpose of relocating his office, which is now in my yard.

Sons William H., George W., R.W., & Taylor Morgan (jointly)  
258.5 acres near Falling River, adjoining the property of William H. Wingfield, conveyed by Mr. Lynch.

Granddaughter Roberta W. Morgan  
\$100 cash.

Wife Sophia W. Morgan  
202 acres, being the residue of my Pigeon Run property, during her lifetime, then to be divided among above-named sons. But, son Taylor is to receive \$300 extra in value.

Co-executors: sons William, George, and Robert Morgan.

Dated January 18, 1877, probated June Session 1877.

Witnesses: Robert Lemon, R.H. Robertson, C.W. Flynn, and John N. Clement.

Appraisers appointed: John N. Clement, William C. Perrow, R.A. Elliott, H.H. Withers, and C.W. Flynn. They made an inventory of Richard's personal estate on August 9, 1877, and it was recorded in Will Book 14, page 458, on August 13, 1877. Total value was \$658.32, including the following bonds:

On December 1, 1877, a sale of Richard's personal property was held. The results were recorded February 25, 1878, in Will Book 15, page 29. Total Value was \$495.53. Buyers were (in order):
