LYNCHBURG RETIRED TEACHERS ASSOCIATION

The Lynchburg Retired Teachers Association, of Lynchburg, Virginia, was organized for the purposes of helping retired teachers "maintain identity with the teaching profession," of advancing "the welfare of retired teachers," of fostering "good fellowship among retired teachers," and of promoting the "involvement of retired teachers in community affairs."

Among its activities, the Association sponsors the Edward Christian Glass Future Teacher Scholarship, honoring the memory of Dr. E. C. GLASS, superintendent of Lynchburg schools from 1879 until 1931. The scholarship is awarded annually to senior students in the local high schools who show "outstanding merit" in "leadership, scholastic achievement," and who plan to enter the teaching field.
